## **Community Players' President's Message**

Hello and welcome to our second production of the 2019-2020 season, *One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest*. The play's story has an intriguing history. It started as a novel by Ken Kesey, published in 1962, and then adapted for the stage in 1963.

Many may be familiar with the blockbuster film version in 1975, starring Jack Nicholson, which won five Academy Awards, including best picture. The story was inspired by Kesey's experiences working as an orderly in a mental hospital. The abuses he witnessed in the name of bureaucracy became a gripping story of institutional oppression. As is often the case with uncomfortable truths, the novel met with opposition. Parents in many communities whose school teachers assigned students to read it protested to school boards. This may not be surprising given societal views on mental illness in the 1960s. However, as recently as the year 2000, parents in a California school district challenged it as "garbage." They most likely did so because it is often easier to avoid challenging issues than to face them.

The story you are about to see is indeed disturbing. This story and its language are harsh. It will likely evoke a variety of feelings such as anger and disbelief. Today's mentally ill patients, I hope, are not subjected to the treatment the play's characters face. You may ask, then, why produce such a disturbing story? Speaking only for myself I would respond that our world is sometimes a dark place. Confronting the uncomfortable is perhaps one way to deal with it. Perhaps we even have an obligation to do so given that the stigma attached to mental illness endures. Its effects are perhaps more subtle, such as insurance limitations for mental health coverage as just one example. Thankfully, there is an active and committed community of mental health practitioners dedicated to helping people navigate the many issues they face.

I applaud them — and I applaud Pete Cuesta and his talented cast/crew for taking on this challenging piece.

## **Director's Message**

Well, I have arrived at my second production! *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* is a daunting prospect with multiple characters with intricate backstories. Many of us know the story and have seen the movie, and yet I feel this play gives you more: more background, more depth in each character and more chances to understand and appreciate the struggles, the human condition.

In this production I have been very fortunate to be able to work with some amazingly talented people both on stage and off. They all richly deserve my heartfelt thanks. Just know that every aspect of what you're seeing was created by someone who loves what they do and doesn't make a dime doing it.

To my family, my wonderful wife and my fantastic daughters, thank you so much for your participation and support. I couldn't have done this without you!

And for you, Community Players' constant audience, first time viewers, advertisers and patrons, we appreciate your coming out to see these productions. I sincerely hope that you enjoy watching them as much as we enjoy making them. Thank you!
