Ticket Order Instructions

Patrons should call Players' phone (410-546-0099) to get their Patron discount code. Each Patron will get a unique code, good for one viewing of the show.

Everyone needs to follow these steps to purchase tickets...

1. On the CPOS website or social media post, click on the poster to get to the website.

- 2. Search for Community Players.
- 3. Click on Almost Maine poster.
- 4. Click on Purchase and select the date you plan to view the show.

5. Complete the payment information on the next screen. Patrons enter coupon code. Others enter credit card information and related personal information. Submit.

6. Patrons should follow the directions on the next screen.

7. Confirmation screen will follow stating that access code will follow in an email.

8. Once you receive your access code, you can view the show from the email or return to Showtix4U to view.

Community Players of Salisbury Scholarship

The Community Players of Salisbury, Inc is one of the oldest continuously operating community theaters in Maryland. In 1937 a group of 26 charter members hoped to bring culture and pure entertainment to the Eastern Shore while providing an outlet for people interested in dramatics. Players was organized under the Recreation Division of the Works Progress Administration (WPA) in May of 1938.

Each spring Community Players of Salisbury will award grants up to \$500 to two high school seniors from Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County and/or Delmar area public, private or home-schooled programs, depending on suitable applicants and availability of funds.

Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must:

- A. Be a graduating high school senior in a Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County or Delmar public, private or home school program
- B. Have applied for admission to a post-secondary institution
- C. Have participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions or be a member of a family that has participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions.
- D. Have financial need as evidenced by the FAFSA

The award shall be made under the following specific conditions:

- Each candidate must submit a completed Community Players of Salisbury scholarship application.
- 2. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the student and shall be used for payment of normal school expenses such as tuition, school fees, room, board or books.
- 3. Student or their family must have participated in Community of Players of Salisbury productions.
- Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Board of Directors of the Community Players of Salisbury.
- 5. Winner will be announced during the student's senior award program or at a Community Players of Salisbury function or meeting.
