

FRONT OF THE HOUSE

When most of us think about aspects of production, we think about getting the actors rehearsed and costumed the set built and decorated and getting all that on stage. We seldom think about getting the audience in their seats. Because managing the front of the house has been done so adeptly by Carol Alex and Mary Veise for so many shows, it was just something that happened. We miss them both. Having lost those two fine Players, it fell upon me to be House Manager for **Streetcar** and **Noises Off**. Being new to the job and having Covid to contend with, I was fortunate to be able to get some excellent help. So here is a big thank you to our ushers

When we did **Streetcar** in June, the local case rate for COVID was one per day. This was down from a peak of sixty-two in January, when we had to cancel the scheduled winter and spring shows, one of which was **Streetcar**. In June, we still had to take moderate precautions, with masks required in the lobby, but not when seated in the theater. There was a big spike of cases in the summer. It peaked at fifty in mid-September. It was seventeen for **Noises Off**, so we used more strict precautions, including alternate row seating, pod seating, and requiring masks at all times.


Getting the audience into their seats was more challenging, and we would like to thank these ushers who did it: Jim and Jean King, Jason and Holly Bruce, Betty Messick, Lou Elin Sheller, Kevin Shertz, Judy Sanders, Andy Renfrew, Bobbie Calloway, Betty Metzger, and Debby Nagel.

A special shout out goes to Wicomico Sheriff's Deputy Jennifer Hall, who went above and beyond as our security officer. She lent a friendly helping hand in the lobby, pointing people to the box office or will call table, reminding people to put on masks as necessary, and even grabbing a few masks from the box we provided to hand out to audience members who forgot to bring them.

As I write this, COVID cases have had a slight spike this week. We obviously can't predict what it will be like in late January, when we do **Spelling Bee**.

We are happy to be able to use the theater at Wor-Wic. Precautions will depend on Wor-Wic's policy and our own judgment. It is very likely that we will have to limit ticket sales to permit social distancing. For that reason, it would be advisable to get your tickets as soon as possible.


