Director's Message

Welcome to a show that playfully merges past and present as well as hints for the future, at least for a television actor pondering a career on stage rather than in front of a camera. The past is in the present in the form of William Shakespeare's classic tragedy, *Hamlet*. If you and your family were guests on "Family Feud" and Steve Harvey said, "We surveyed 100 people and asked them, "What is the most famous Shakespeare quote?" It's a safe bet that the number one answer would be "To be or not to be; that is the question." There is, however, another famous quote in *Hamlet* and that is "This above all, to thine own self be true." It is this line, I believe, that is central to the story and characters in *I Hate Hamlet*.

TV actor Andrew Rally is having, as one character says, "a career crisis" brought on by his hasty decision to play Hamlet after his tv show has been canceled. As the play unfolds, Andrew struggles with the following questions: What is his true self as an actor, the stage or the tv screen? What is his true self as a boyfriend, the need for intimacy or the compassion for his girl-friend's uncertainty? Which of those should he "be" or strive "not to be." Most of the characters in the play, particularly the ghost of John Barrymore, push Andrew to "be" Hamlet, while a fast-talking Hollywood writer-director-producer tries to lure Andrew back to television with a mega-bucks offer for a new series. What will Andrew ultimately decide to be or not to be in order to be true to himself? You'll see—and enjoy the ride.

A brief note for those of a certain age: John Barrymore was part of the legendary Barrymore family acting dynasty. His career-defining role was indeed that of "Hamlet" on Broadway in 1922. Some audience members may not have heard of him. So, if it helps, he was Drew Barrymore's grandfather.

A New York Times Theatre Critic, described *I Hate Hamlet* as "unapologetically silly and at times hilarious." I am, of course, biased, but I believe this production delivers that description, especially given the team of actors and technical crew who made this happen. No production happens with just the actors and a director. The technical crew members are the unseen heroes who design and build a set, decorate that set, design and deliver lighting and sound to enhance the audience experience, find dozens of props, acquire and create stunning costumes—It most definitely takes a village. To all involved in this production, as well as you our supportive audience, let me end with a quote from another Shakespeare classic, *Twelfth Night*,

"Thanks, and thanks and ever thanks."

Synopsis

I Hate Hamlet tells the story of a famous TV star, Andrew Rally, whose show has been cancelled, so he reluctantly agrees to appear in Hamlet in the renowned Shakespeare in the Park series in New York City. His real estate agent, who also happens to be a medium, has managed to lease the apartment which once belonged to legendary actor, John Barrymore, whose performance in Hamlet is considered a classic. After a séance and other comic shenanigans, Barrymore appears and offers to coach Andrew on how to best play Hamlet. Andrew is petrified to play the role and wants to decline the role but his girlfriend, resolved to maintain her virginity until she is sure that Andrew is "the one," swoons at the thought of her boyfriend playing the role. Enter Andrew's talent agent, who once had an affair with Barrymore and the stage is set for non-stop laughs. Andrew decides to accept the role, as well as Barrymore's guidance. When a Hollywood friend and producer, however, shows up with a lucrative TV offer, Andrew must decide between Shakespeare, whom his girlfriend adores, or the TV offer that comes with serious money.

<u>Scene</u>

The action takes place in the late 1980s in the Greenwich Village New York apartment once owned by the famous stage and screen actor John Barrymore.






