- 1. I updated an application for a Maryland Historical Trust Grant of \$10,000 for a production based on Frederick Douglass' life, which will be held next year if approved. The first application was well received, but the panelists wanted me to provide more information, especially regarding how the production could be brought into the classroom.
- 2. I completed a final report for the Community Foundation of Eastern Shore grant in which we received funds for door to the new green room.
- 3. I am happy to report that the Coastal Association of Realtors grant that I applied for has been approved. It is for \$500 and goes toward the Summer Workshop. We have received the funds already,
- 4. I bought two tickets to the "Let's Do Lunch Arts" luncheon for Salisbury Wicomico Arts Council to be held in June. It is an obligation to do so as part of the grant requirements.
